These events will be open to competitors, on motorcycles, who are holders of a current MA licence and who are members of the Whyalla Motorcycling Club (WMCC). The events will be conducted under the GCR's of MA and these Supplementary Regulations.

The promoter will appoint all officials for these events.

Entries:

All entries will be taken on the mornings of the events.

Fees:

All WMCC members with a MA licence	\$7:00
One day WMCC membership	\$2:00
One day MA (SA) licence	\$25:00

Classes:

Juniors:

50cc Auto and 65cc	3 laps, 4 heats (short course)
85cc, 125cc	3 laps, 4 heats

Seniors:

Up to 125cc	4 laps, 4 heats
Up to 250cc	4 laps, 4 heats
300cc and over	4 laps, 4 heats

The promoter reserves the right to reject any entry and to combine, alter or delete any event that has insufficient entries.



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Awards:

Pennants or ribbons will be awarded on the day for each class contended.
A Junior "Best and Fairest" award will also be presented.

Series trophies will be awarded at the WMCC's Annual Presentation.

Note: Series points will only be awarded to those riders who have full Club membership.

Machines will be examined from 8:00am to 9:30am **sharp!**

Evidence of Club membership, MA licence, helmet and bike are to be produced.

Track: Track licence number: - 6080

The track is located approximately 12km south of Whyalla. It consists of man-made jumps, drop-offs, straights and tabletops.

Special Notes:

ALCOHOL is not permitted in the pit area.

Dumping of fuel or oil on the ground is prohibited. COMPETITORS are responsible for the removal of their waste fuel or oil.

CONTRACT TO PARTICIPATE IN MOTORCYCLE SPORTING EVENT AND/OR ACTIVITY

HEREBY AGREE with the persons, organisations and bodies corporate whose names appear in Schedule 1 (hereinafter collectively called “the organisers”) that I am by this agreement entitled to in the motorcycle meeting listed in the Schedule 2 (hereinafter called “the meeting”) at the venue listed in Schedule 3(hereinafter called “the venue”) on the terms and conditions set out in this document.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF RISKS, DANGERS AND OBLIGATIONS

2. I ACKNOWLEDGE that the sport of motorcycle racing is dangerous and that by engaging in the sport and participating in the race meeting I take and am exposed to certain risks and dangers and am under certain obligations as follows:

- that I may be injured, physically or mentally, and may be killed;
- that my machinery or equipment may be damaged, lost or destroyed;
- that other competitors may ride dangerously or with lack of skill;
- that track or event conditions may be hazardous and may vary without warning or predictability;
- that the organisers, officials, landowners or track operators and any agent or representatives of those in charge of race meetings are frequently obliged to make decisions under pressure of time and/or events;
- that any policy of insurance of or in respect of my life or physical or mental health may be avoided;
- that there may be no or inadequate facilities for treatment or transport of me if I am injured;
- that I have an obligation to myself and others to compete safely and within the rules of competition.

INDEMNITY GIVEN TO ORGANISERS

3. IN CONSIDERATION of the acceptance of me as an entrant at the meeting **I AGREE TO INDEMNIFY** the organisers and each of them in the following manner:

- that I participate in the race meeting at my sole risk and responsibility;
- that I accept the venue as it stands with all or any defect hidden or exposed;
- that I indemnify and hold harmless the organisers, their respective servants, agents or officials against any actions or claims which may be made by me or on my behalf or by other parties for or in respect of or arising out of my death or any injury, loss or damage caused to me or to my machine or equipment whether caused by negligence, breach of contract or in any other matter whatsoever.
